# Examination Performance Summary 2018

## GCSE RESULTS 2018

We're delighted to announce another year of successful **GCSE results** where Hillcrest students achieved outcomes at grades 4+, 5+ and 7+ above the national figures.

**76%** of students achieved the new pass grade (4+) in both English and Maths.

**48%** of students achieved the strong pass grade (5+) in both English and Maths.

**25%** of all results were at grade 7, 8 or 9.

**86%** of students achieved a grade 4 to 9 in English and **82%** in Maths.

**74%** of students achieved a grade 5 to 9 in English and **54%** in Maths.

**46%** of students achieved the Ebacc set of subjects with standard pass (grade 4+) in Maths, English, Humanities, Languages and 2 or more Science qualifications.

**26%** of students achieved the Ebacc set of subjects with strong pass (grade 5+) in Maths, English, Humanities, Languages and 2 or more Science qualifications.

**Attainment 8 Score = 51.8**

EBacc APS=4.77 (71% of students were entered for the Ebacc set of subjects)
